After what seems like a fairly short wait, Avengers: Infinity War is suddenly already on home video. And while the film was already the longest and more difficult entry into the Marvel franchise, there are still some lingering questions that you may have had about the main plot. Fortunately, in terms of getting the characters from point A to point B, the deleted scenes on Infinity War Blu-ray are endlessly useful. Here are three plot points that the new deleted scenes make much clearer. This whole Gamora thing with a soul stone is explained in the theatrical cut of the film, you may have been confused about why Gamora knew where the soul stone was, and why she got her adoptive sister Nebula to lie about it. In one remote scene called Father's Choice, Tonos and Gamora walk down memory lane, where Tonos explains exactly why he chose her to find the Stone of the Soul. This helps clarify the fact that in none of the previous films featuring Gamora and Nebula (both Guardians of the Galaxy movies) nor any of them mentioned the Stone of The Soul even once. In a remote scene, some of this backstory hastily explained, but more poignantly, the scene really drives home the idea that Thanos felt like Gamora betrayed his family, which is how he rationalizes sacrificing it to get what he wants. To make these moments even more intimidating, the special effects are not completely complete, meaning Tonos's mouth doesn't move when he speaks. Scary! As Guardians find Titan also makes way more sense when Tony Stark, Peter Parker and Dr. Strange find roughly half of Guardians of the Galaxy on the planet Titan, earthy superheroes are a little confused. How do these guys get to this planet? But, the audience is a little confused, too. Earlier in the film, after Gamora was kidnapped by Thanos, we don't really know what Star-Lord, Mantis and Drax are doing until they suddenly join forces with Iron Man and company. But, the remote scene of the Guardians get their Groove Back explains that Nebula sent the Guardians special coded transmissions to tell them exactly where to go, and that Gamora - at least at that time - was still alive. Iron Man's bodyguard deals with the paparazzi O'okay, so perhaps no one was really wondering how an Iron Man could jog through a New York park without being photographed in the press. After all, we all buy the fact that these superheroes exist in the first place, why would we be concerned about hyper-realistic details like Tony Stark's privacy. Well, because these things help create realism! And it turns out the deleted scenes showed what Stark's bodyguard - Blessed Hogan (played by Iron Man director Jon Favreau) - did during the Infinity War. Basically, he's making sure no one takes unauthorized photos of Tony and Pepper. Look, just because other superheroes are helping to protect super-ducted rocks from space doesn't mean Heverie's work isn't. You feel the Lucky Part of the Avengers (and you should) this remote scene helps explain where it was during the movie. Now, if only we could figure out where Hawkeye was during all this? After all, now we know where Ant-Man was! Avengers: Infinity War is out on Blu-ray today. It is also available for digital download. During Avengers: Infinity War, fans hoped Marvel would actually do it, killing some of their favorite characters. Well, be careful what you want. In the film, a whopping 16 characters die - at least, it would seem. This basically ensures that some of these deaths will not be permanent, but some are likely to be. So what is it? Who's back and who's not? Here's a look at the characters killed in Infinity War who will surely return, as well as those who are likely to remain dead. Warning: This article will contain major spoilers for Avengers: Infinity War. The 12 characters seemingly die at the end of the film Thanos in Infinity War. Marvel Infinity War establishes early on that if Tonos gets all the Infinity Stones and snaps his fingers, half of life in the universe will cease to exist. And that's exactly how the film ends: Thanos gets the stones, snaps his fingers, and half the population disappears. This includes many of our heroes. In case you've lost track, the characters that would seem to die when Thanos snaps Bucky Barnes, Black Panther, Groot, Scarlet Witch, Sam Wilson, Mantis, Drax, Star-Lord, Doctor Strange, Spider-Man, Maria Hill, and Nick Fury. So wait, is Marvel seriously just killing the 12 main characters, in addition to the four others who died earlier in the film? What is going on? Next: This fact changes the way we look at the end of the cliffhanger. Many of these characters have already been confirmed to bring back the Black Panther to Marvel Studios if you're not out of time with The Marvel news even a little bit, the shocking death at the end of Infinity War certainly doesn't phase you in. After all, we know for sure that some of these characters will return to future movies. For example, Spider-Man has a film, which is scheduled for release in July 2019. With Black Panther, it must be plainly obvious that Marvel is not going to kill its new most popular character. But the Black Panther sequel has also been clearly confirmed to be on the way. In addition, Guardians of the Galaxy Vol. 3 is out in 2020. However, literally every Keeper dies in infinity war, except for the rocket. So if that third film is just about Rocket drifting into space while listening to sad songs on Peter zone, obviously these characters are all coming back. But how? Next: There is evidence of how this cliffhanger will be solved in the comic. In the comics, everyone who disappears after the snap returns Thanos snaps a finger. | Marvel Comics For more sense of what's in store, we just have to Comics. In Infinity Gauntlet, the storyline that Infinity War is based on, snap snap just like it does in the movie. And in the comic, every person who disappears after the snap ends comes back to life to the end of the story. The Infinity Glove is used to set everything back to normal and bring everyone back. Of course, the comic is a lot different from the movie. A completely separate set of characters die, and the circumstances under which they return will almost certainly not be the same as on the screen. However, it seems a pretty safe bet that Marvel raises the idea of characters apparently dying at the hands of Thanos, only to return, for Avengers 4. Next: Avengers 4 can show characters coming back this way. Characters may actually be trapped in the soul world in Marvel comics. Marvel.com technically, we haven't really seen any of these characters die in the traditional sense. They only disappeared, seemingly disappearing from existence. But one explanation for how they will return lies in the source material once again. In the comics, the Stone of the Soul has the right to catch people in a pocket dimension known as the Soul World. The theory among fans now is that those who died at the end of the Infinity War actually just got transported here. So it seems that Avengers 4 will be about the original team of heroes teaming up to save a new generation. How will they do it? This remains to be seen, but if they can get the Stone of Souls out of Tonos, they may be able to free their friends. One theory is that Captain America will die in the process, and Tony killed him as a sacrifice, as Tonos killed Gamora. It is also possible that all the original Avengers will die to save the new ones. Next: These two characters are unfortunately likely dead forever. Heimdall and Loki are likely to remain dead. Loki holds the Tesseract. Marvel course, there were other deaths in the film beyond those who disappeared in the snap. The film immediately began with the deaths of Heimdall and Loki. And unfortunately, these characters seem likely to remain dead. Both of them had pretty complete storylines, and besides, we don't even know if we get more Thor movies. Loki in particular seems unlikely to return. Thanos specifically has a line about how there will be no resurrections this time, which seems like a meta-reference. It would also be utterly funny if Loki dies, only to return, twice in two separate films. Unfortunately, we think these two remain dead. That being said, Tom Hiddleston, however, will appear again in Avengers 4; The filming of the scene, which takes place at the Battle of New York, shows scenes, so Hiddleston will play a version of Loki from the 2012 film The Avengers. Next: This other character probably won't come back, either. The vision probably won't come back, either vision in Avengers: Infinity War. Marvel Studios So what about Vision? Will he stay dead, or can he come back? It seems that go anyway. On the one hand, Tonos very clearly kills Vision in the film, so there is no ambiguity about his death as is with those who disappeared in the snap. On the other hand, Vision was basically just an AI with a physical vessel. So is it possible that it can be restored if our heroes get the Stone of Mind back? There's also always the possibility of characters changing reality through time travel or some other Infinity Stone shenanigans that allows Vision to return. However, Vision's death was strong enough that it would have been a disappointment. He's also a rather minor character that it seems that someone Marvel would be willing to lose. In the meantime, we predict that the Vision will remain dead. Next: It's still unclear if this character will return, but we think it will. Gamora could return if she's trapped in the soul world of zoe Saldana as Gamora in Guardians of the Galaxy Vol. 2. Marvel Studios Character whose status is hardest to predict is Gamora. Her death is the most significant in the film, and so it can be assumed that Marvel will be willing to commit to it. In addition, Marvel Studios President Kevin Feige said that some of the upcoming deaths will be permanent. But an important fact to consider is that there is a third Guardians film coming out in 2020. So far these films have functioned well on their own, so what would director James Gunn really be good with one of the leads of his trilogy dying between parts? Gunn said you'll be able to watch three Guardians movies on your own without the Avengers, and they'll make sense; one would think that Gamora dying from the screen would prevent this from being. He also said that Gamora would be a large part of Guardians 3. Finally, zoe Saldana has previously said she's into Avengers 4, though it may just be a flashback or a vision sequence. So how could Gamora come back if we saw her fall to death? Well, there has been some indication through a plethora of photos that Avengers 4 involves time travel, so it's possible that the surviving heroes go back in time to prevent all deaths in infinity war going on in the first place. It is also possible that Gamora was also trapped in the World of the Soul; maybe that's what the Scene Thanos talk to young Gamora indicates.
